### **Read v18-20**

*Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. <sup>19</sup>Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*

### **Questions / activities to think it through**

1. In verse 18 how much authority / power does Jesus have?
2. What does the mighty Lord Jesus say to his disciples in v19-20?
3. This isn't a command just for the twelve - how can we tell our friends about Jesus?
4. Get a map of the world or a globe. Ask your children to tell you about the different nations e.g., biggest country, favourite country, country where someone you know lives etc.
5. What does it mean to "make disciples of all nations"? Tell them what a missionary is. Do you know any missionaries past or present?
6. How do you feel about telling your friends about Jesus?
7. What encouragement does Jesus give us in verse 20?
8. Share the names of 2 friends you want to become a Christian. Pray for them!
